## Standardized Dress Code Policy

### *Approved Standard Apparel*

#### **Shirts or Tops**

- Any solid color
- Short sleeved or long sleeved acceptable - No sleeveless
- Acceptable shirts **with collars** include: Polo pullover, Oxford, turtlenecks, mock turtlenecks, button down Henley
- Logos or brand emblems may not be larger than 3/4”.
- Sweaters, sweater vests and sweatshirts must be worn over collared shirts and must comply with approved solid colors.
- Shirts do not have to be tucked in unless shirt extends below the hips. Tapered tail shirts must be tucked in.

#### **Bottoms**

- Solid color pants, shorts, skorts, skirts or jumpers in khaki (no olive), navy blue, or black; cargo, carpenter and corduroy are acceptable
- If belts are worn, they must be appropriate length and remain fastened.
- Pants and shorts must be fitted at the waist and crotch
- No oversized or baggy pants
- Skirt, shorts, skort, and jumper length may be no shorter than fingertip or mid thigh.

#### **Socks**

- Socks must comply with approved colors.

#### **Miscellaneous**

- Shoes, jackets, and accessories must follow the WFISD Elementary Dress Code

#### **“Spirit Day” (Fridays)**

- Students will be allowed to wear blue jeans or blue jean shorts (hemmed and meeting dress code criteria) if they wear a Crockett spirit shirt.
- If a student does not wear a Crockett spirit shirt, they must wear standard uniform apparel.

#### **Free Dress Day**

- The last Wednesday of each month will be a “free dress day”. Free dress apparel must meet the regular WFISD Elementary Dress Code.
