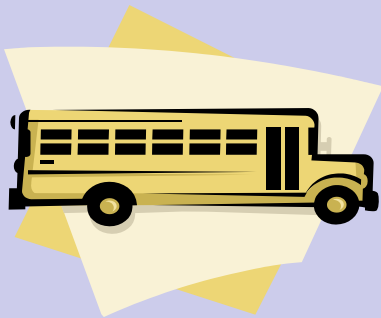


Staff Members Agree To:
