

Fowler Expectations & Citizenship Plan

Conduct and work habit grades are earned on a weekly basis (Grades 3-5). Grades earned will be reflected on the 9 week report card. Standards based grades will be given at each 9 week report card (Grades KG-2nd).

Fowler Expectations and consequences are listed below.

Fowler Conduct Expectations:

1. Talk at appropriate times.
2. Keep hands, feet, and objects to self.
3. Be respectful of people and property.
4. Follow directions/stay on task.

CONDUCT Consequences:

- 1 Red Dojo = warning
- 3 Red Dojos = student conference
- 5 Red Dojos = parent phone call
- 6 Red Dojos = lunch D-Hall
- 8 Red Dojos = office referral

Work Habit Expectations:

1. Respond to directions when given.
2. Complete all assignments on time.
3. Bring all materials to class and be prepared to work.

WORK HABIT Consequences:

- 1 mark = warning
- 2 marks = student conference
- 3 marks = parent contact
- 4 marks = lunch D-Hall
- 5 marks = after school D-Hall (3:20-4:00)

The consequences are applicable for each week of school. However, each week the consequences will start over. Work Habit after school D-Hall can be assigned for marks of a 1-week period or chronic behavior of the student.

Scenario: Julie receives 6 Red Dojo marks in one school week. She will serve a lunch d-hall. The following week, Julie receives 3 marks. She will have a student conference with her teacher.

Office referral guidelines: a student will receive an office referral for every 8 red ClassDojo marks earned during one school week. Office referrals are accumulative for the entire year. These consequences **DO NOT** start over weekly. The consequences are as follows:

Office referrals

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| 1 office referral – 1 day after school d-hall | 6 office referrals – 3 days of In School Suspension |
| 2 office referrals – 2 days after school d-hall | 7 office referrals – 1 days of Out of School Suspension |
| 3 office referrals – 3 days after school d-hall | 8 office referrals – 2 days of Out of School Suspension |
| 4 office referrals – 1 day of In School Suspension | 9 office referrals – 3 days of Out of School Suspension |
| 5 office referrals – 2 days of In School Suspension | 10 office referrals – Possible DAEP Placement |

Please note: Some offenses are considered severe enough to bypass the ClassDojo mark system, and will result in a direct office referral. Some examples of behavior that would qualify are: fighting, stealing, or academic dishonesty. Consequences for direct referral offenses will be determined by an administration.

A direct office referral will result in a 30 point deduction from the weekly conduct grade.
