



## Prekindergarten Registration

### Step 1: Determine/Confirm Qualifying Status:

To qualify for Prekindergarten a child must be 4 years old by Sept. 1<sup>st</sup> and meet one of the following eligibility criteria:

**1. Be Economically Disadvantaged**

**To confirm:** Take proof of income to Benetta Johnson, Child Nutrition Office, 2015 5th Street, 235-1065, ext. 25003. Proof of income includes one of the following: current TANF or SNAP eligibility letter, current paycheck stub, or current tax return. If eligible take the above paperwork to your child's school with the documents listed in Step #3 below.

**2. Parent is active duty military or was injured/killed while serving in the armed forces**

**To confirm:** Take the following paperwork to your child's school along with the documents listed in Step #3 below: military ID/paperwork confirming orders or letter stating percentage of disability

**3. Child has been in custody of CPS/Foster care or adopted out of foster care**

**To confirm:** Take the following paperwork to your child's school along with the documents listed in Step #3 below: letter with CPS case number, foster care documentation, or letter from DFPS stating the child is eligible for PreK

**4. Child does not speak English**

**To confirm:** Contact Greta Benavides or Amanda Gonzales at 235-1021, ext. 15036 or 15037

**5. Child or family is homeless**

**To confirm:** Contact Debbie Gonzalez at 235--1026, ext. 16036

### Step 2: Complete New Student Application Online:

- If your child is new to WFISD, go to [www.wfisd.net](http://www.wfisd.net), look under District Resources along the right hand side of the page, go to **"2018-19 Student Registration"** and then **"New."** Create your user account with parent/guardian information and then continue through the site to register your child. If you have any questions, please call your child's zoned campus.

### Step 3: Take Documents to Assigned Campus

- Take: proof of eligibility, child's official birth certificate, shot record, Social Security Card, proof of residency (current water, gas, electric bill or lease agreement) and your photo ID
