Dear Parent/Guardian:

I was recently notified that Kirby World Academy has been included on the 2016-2017 Public Education Grant (PEG) list. The Texas Education Agency (TEA) places a school on this list for the following reasons.

- 1) The passing rate on a subject area test of the state assessment is less than or equal to 50 percent in any two of the preceding three years: 2013, 2014, 2015; or
- 2) The school was rated *Improvement Required* by the state accountability system in 2013, 2014, or 2015.

Kirby World Academy “Met Standard” in 2013, 2014, and 2015. However, in 2013 the percentage passing the 8<sup>th</sup> grade social STAAR was 48% and 2014 the percentage passing score was 50%. In 2015, percentage passing on STAAR for 7<sup>th</sup> grade Writing was 45%, 8<sup>th</sup> Science was 43%, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Social Studies was 40%. Kirby World Academy is continuously moving forward and making progress towards increasing student achievement. The faculty and staff at Kirby World Academy are dedicated to ensuring the success for all students.

Under the PEG intradistrict transfer provision, parents of a student enrolled in a campus on the PEG list may apply to transfer to another campus, but a transfer from one PEG school to another PEG school is not allowed. Parents may apply for a PEG transfer for 2016-2017 by contacting the WFISD Student Assignment Office by February 26, 2016. Transfer applications are available in the Student Assignment Office at 1104 Broad Street, Suite 300 or may be downloaded from the District website, [www.wfisd.net](http://www.wfisd.net). Applications must be submitted to the Student Assignment Office for approval by the deadline and may be hand delivered, mailed, faxed to (940) 720- 3104, or emailed to [lmuehlberger@wfisd.net](mailto:lmuehlberger@wfisd.net). Transfer approvals are contingent on space availability at the receiving campus. Parents of transfer students are responsible for transportation.
