Dear Parent/Guardian/Surrogate Parent/Foster Parent:

Transition services are a coordinated set of activities for a student with a disability, which guides the student from school to post-school activities, including post-secondary education, vocational training, integrated employment, continuing and adult education, adult services, independent living, or community participation. Transition services are based on the individual needs of the student taking into account the student's preferences and interests. It includes instruction, related services, community experiences, the development of employment and other post-school adult objectives and when appropriate, acquisition of daily living skills and a functional vocational evaluation. As the Parent/Guardian/Surrogate Parent/Foster Parent, your view is an important part of this planning. We as the ARD committee, value the information about your son or daughter and want to hear you thoughts.

This information will be used along with information from the teachers and your student to complete the required transition part in the annual ARD meeting.
